## 2022 FACT SHEET

### STREET OUTREACH



482 youth were supported by our outreach team.

37% exited from homelessness to a safe and stable place.

### SHELTER



181 youth were provided with shelter.

37% went on to a safe and stable place.

### HOUSING



133 youth entered our housing program.

75% of those who exited have moved on to another stable place.

The total number of unduplicated young people that The PLACE served in 2022.

### EDUCATION



211 youth received educational support services.

### EMPLOYMENT



336 young people received employment support services.

### HEALTH SERVICES



424 youth received health coordination and/or referrals to other health services.

### Who we served

- 56% were male
- 37% were female
- 4% were transgender
- 3% were no single gender
- 26% self identified as LGBTQIA+
- 51% Black, Indigenous, or People of Color (BIPOC)

- 33% had experiences with the foster care system
- 23% had experiences with the criminal justice system
- 63% were youth who had a self identified disability
- 24% had substance use or abuse issues

## COMING SOON...THE LAUNCHPAD

The Launchpad is the Pikes Peak region's first permanent supportive housing development that intervenes to change the trajectory of young people experiencing homelessness. The project includes 50 units designed to house youth age 18-24 with comprehensive support services integrated into their individual development plans.

### Wrap-around support services provided by The PLACE

- Case Management
- Individual counseling and support
- Peer support groups
- Routine medical care
- Personal financial management & budgeting
- Job skills training and education
- Recreational and socialization opportunities
